Meet The Norsemen

 Members of the 1937 Golden Norsemen hail from all parts of Oklahoma. Although they were victorious in their first three games, it appears that many in the student body don't know the players and their home towns. Part of the squad members will be named, others will appear in the next issue.

Beginning with the sophomores, Tom Robertson and Hebert "Chief" Bacon, both ends, hail from Jay. Robertson is one of the two returning regulars.

Gary Bryant, a 185-pound tackle from Shawnee, is an outstanding player and makes up the other half of the regulars from last year's team.

Jack Jones, a 170-pound quarterback from Commerce, has a keen work and good sportsmanship.

In the U. S., soccer is chiefly supported by the foreign-born population. It is played by many prep schools and by public high schools in large cities. But in the United States, soccer is a minor sport.

Bobby Green, 175-pound halfback from Bartlesville and All-State of 1936, is also one of Oklahoma's fastest backs and is a threat any time on the field.

One of the squads work-horses, Roger Cox is a 220-pound fullback from Bartlesville. He has probably averaged more carries per game than any other man on the Norse squad. Cox was Green's running mate in high school.

Bert Donahoe, an outstanding defensive man from Sand Springs, plays end and weighs 170. Another Sand Springs player, Jerry Giles, weighs in at 185 and holds down guard position.

Duane Collins, from Miami looks good at fullback. This is Duane's second year in football. Jim Smith, from Anadarko, weighs 167 and plays defensive tackle.

Another defensive tackle is Ed-ward Davis who weighs 167. Joe Sherman, a 170-pound end, hails from Nowata. Don Collins at the halfback post weighs 170. He is also from Tulsa. Mickey Heasler, weighing 165, shares the quarterback slot with Jones. Mickey is from Picher.
