# ART DEPARTMENT

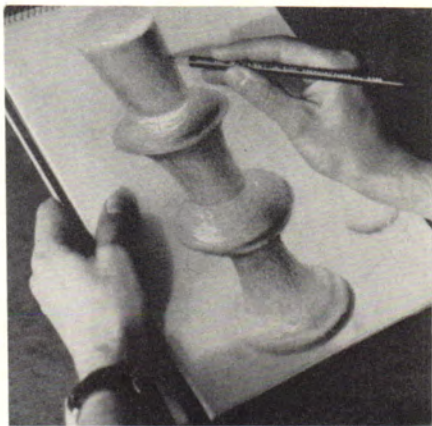

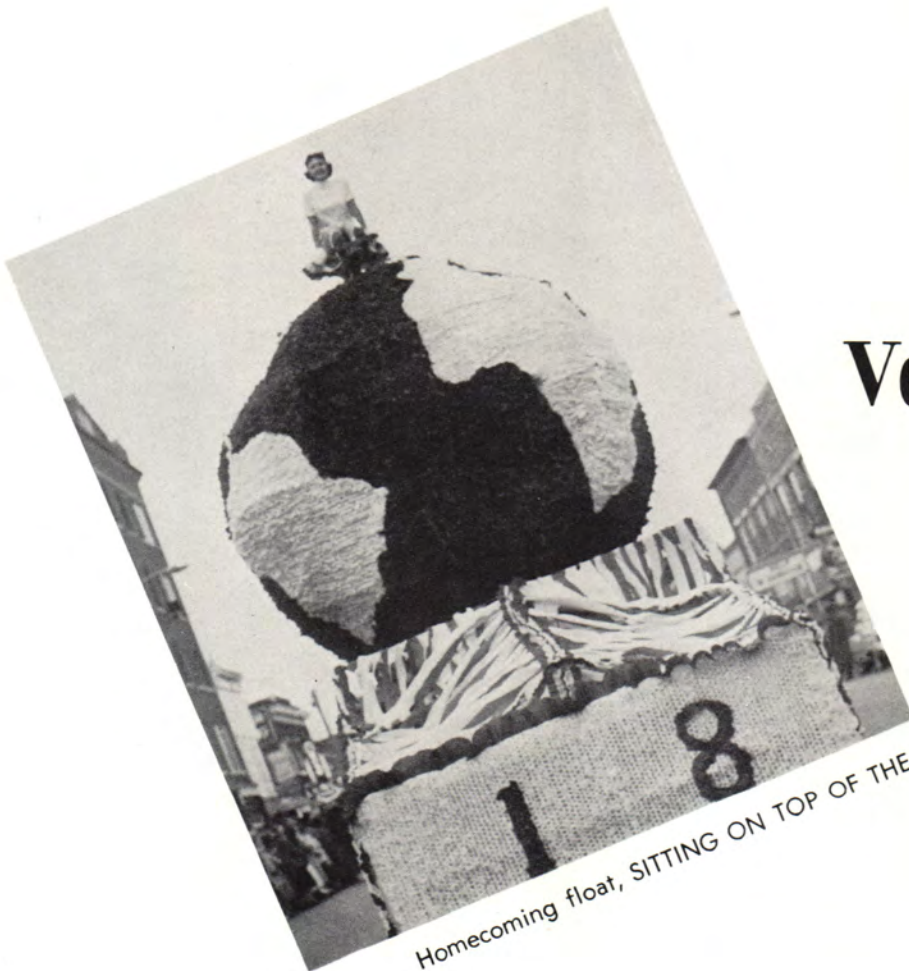
In addition to the **Wind**, there are the laboratories of radio newscasting and publicity work for advanced students.

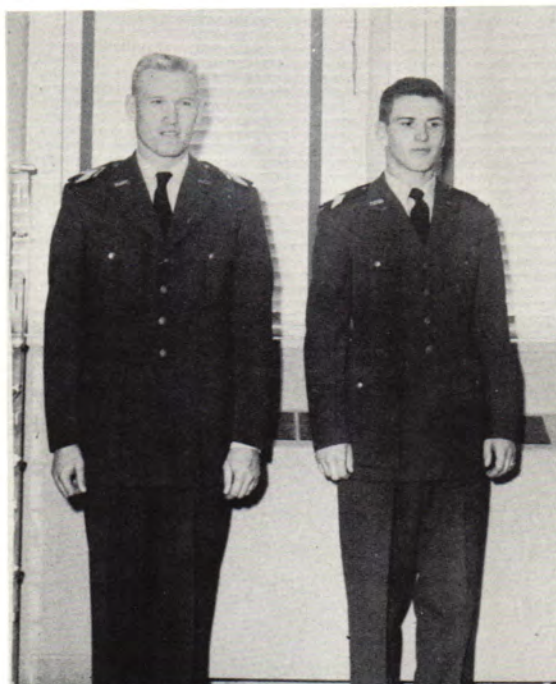
