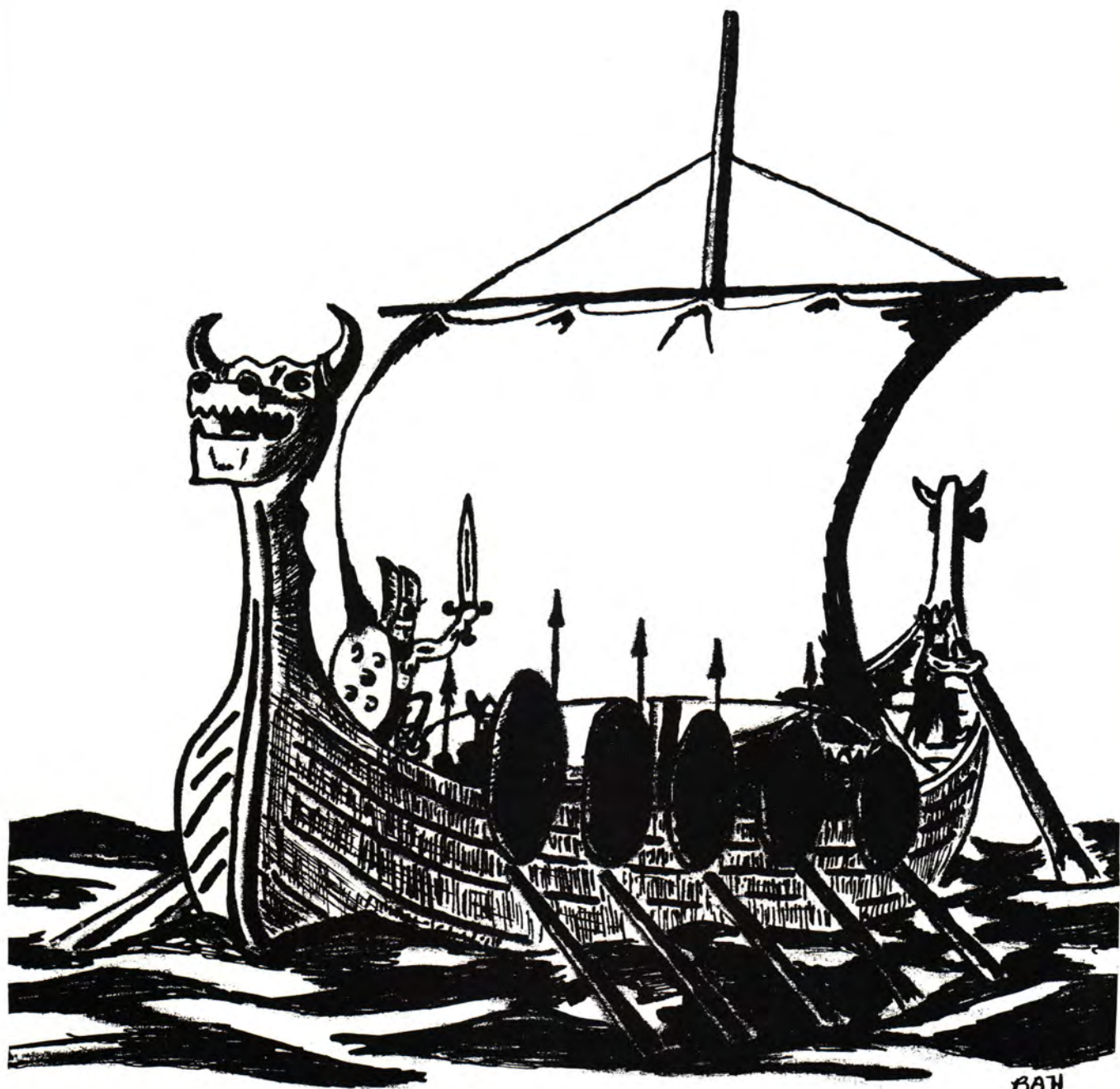

*EXPLOSIVE NORSEMEN RIP RAIDERS 39-0*

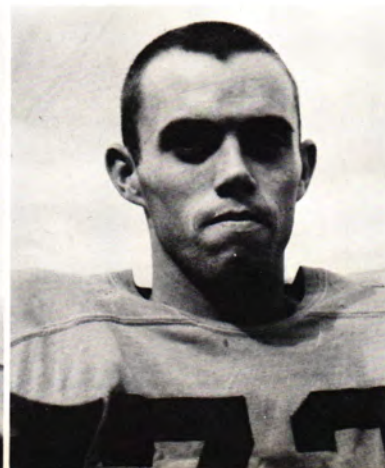

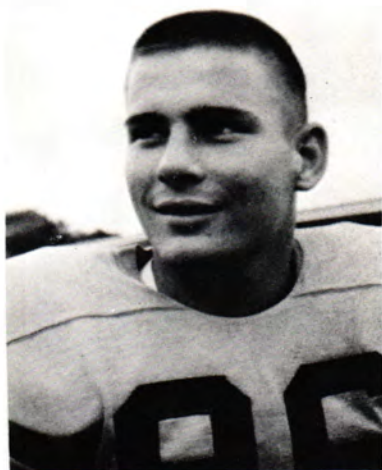
