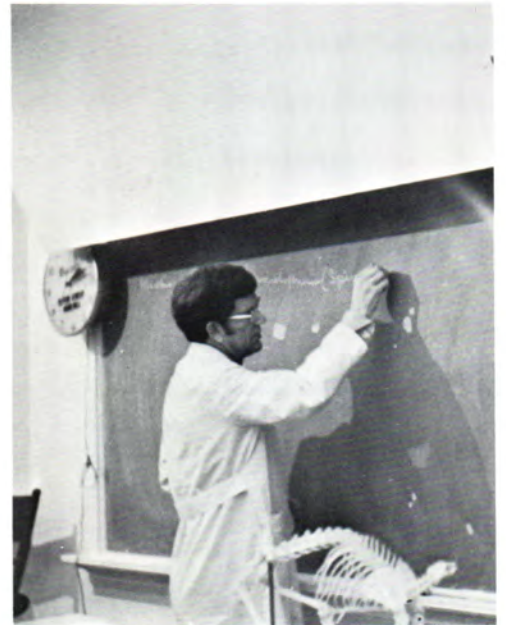

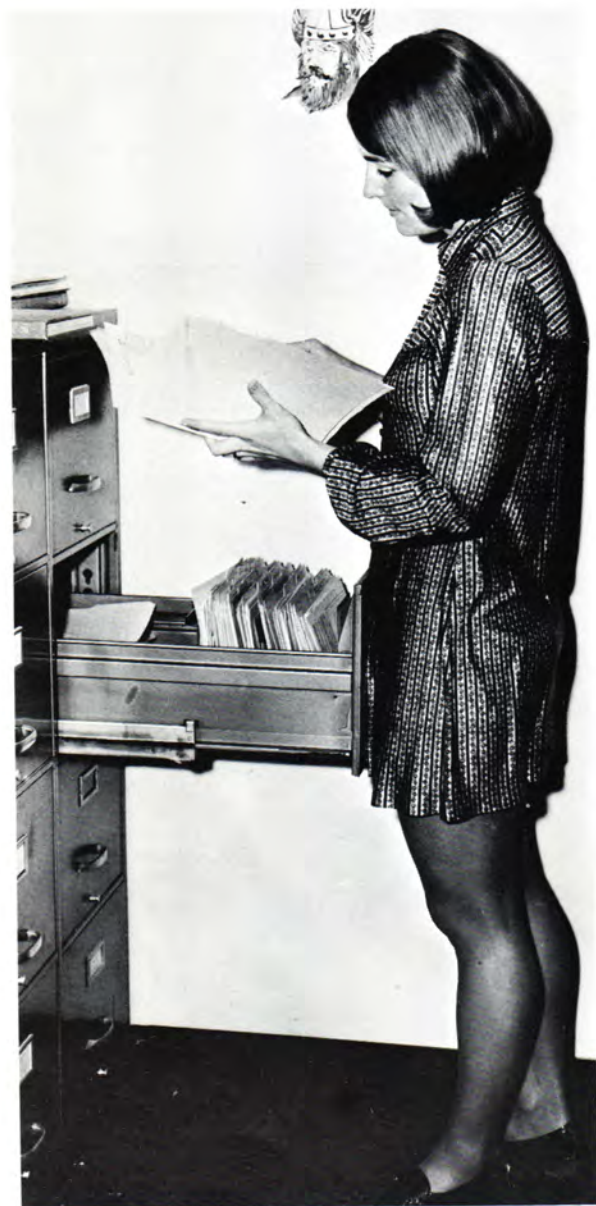

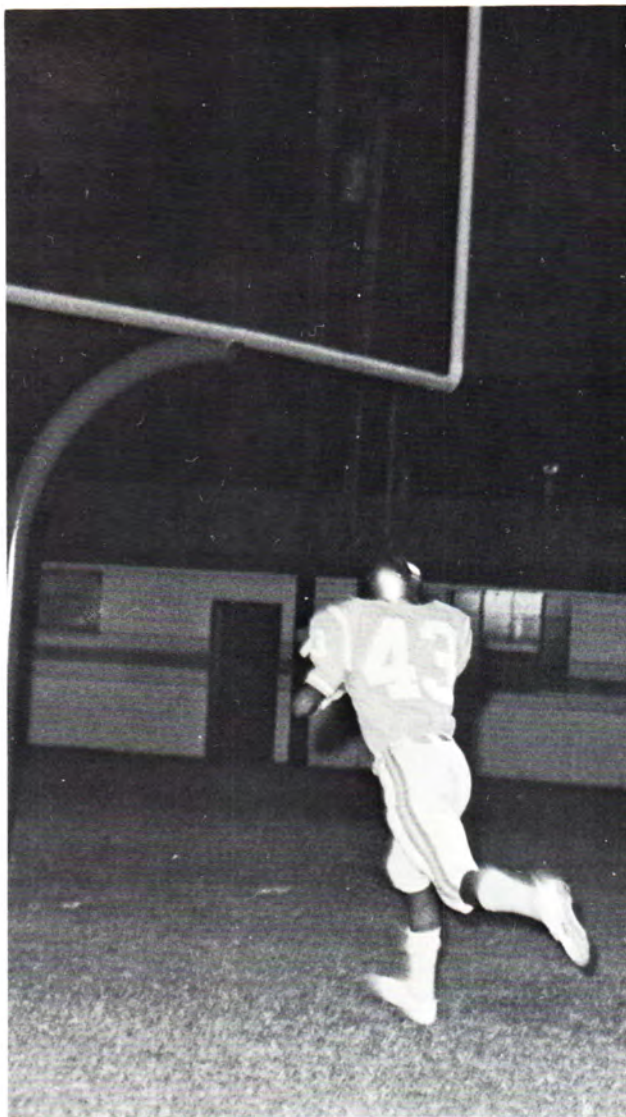


Robert Maxwell

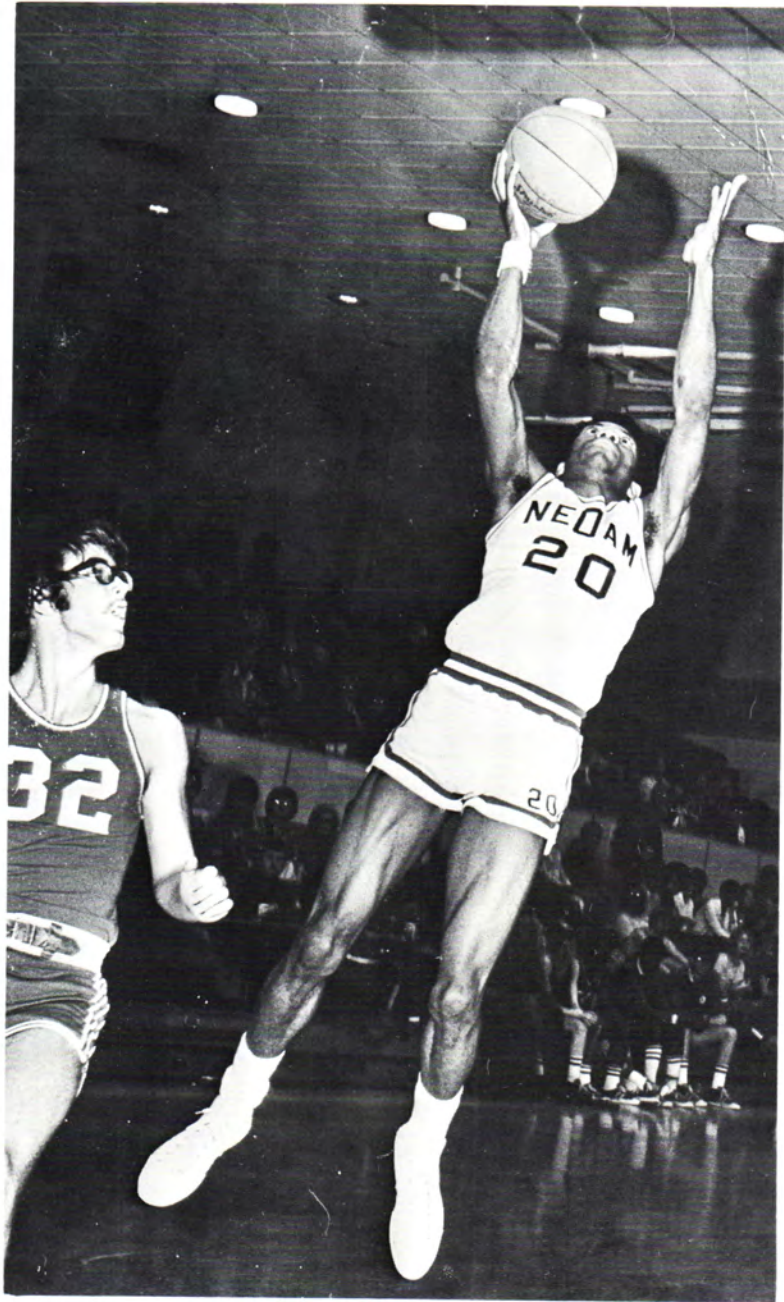

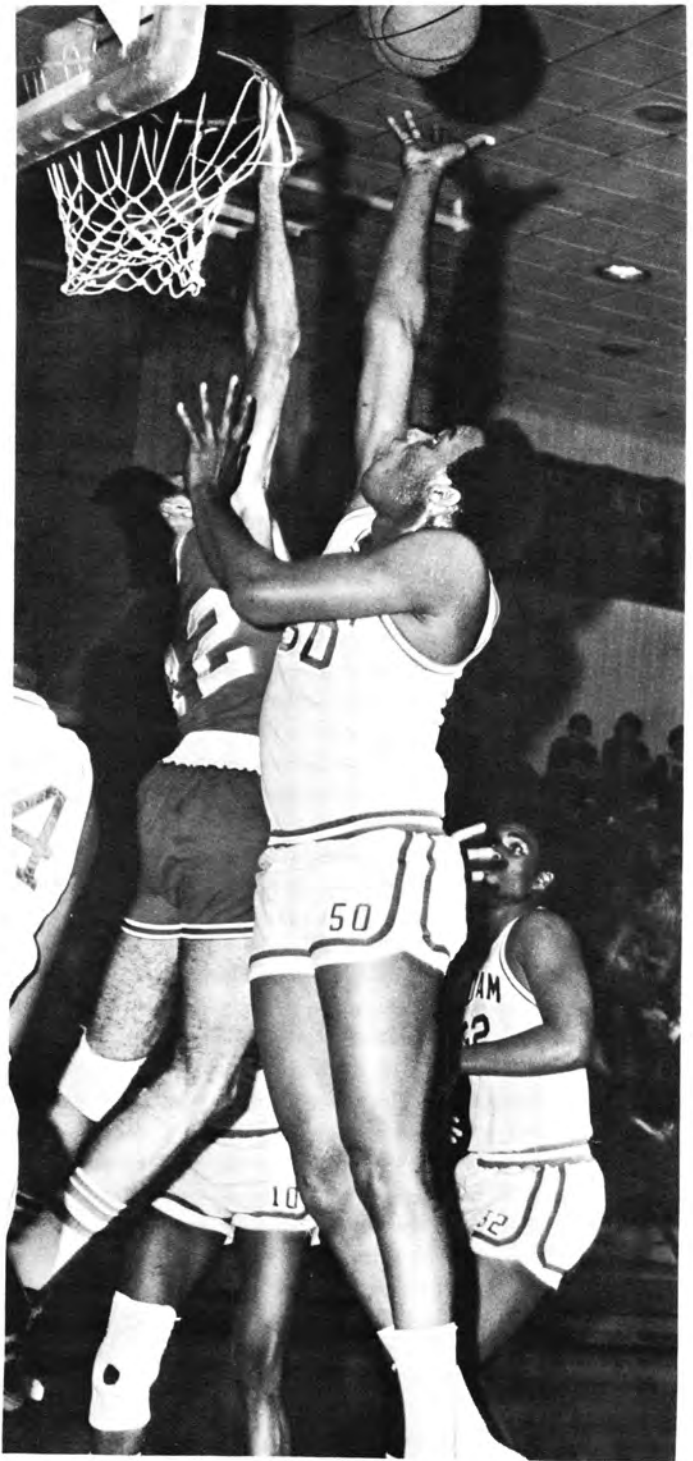

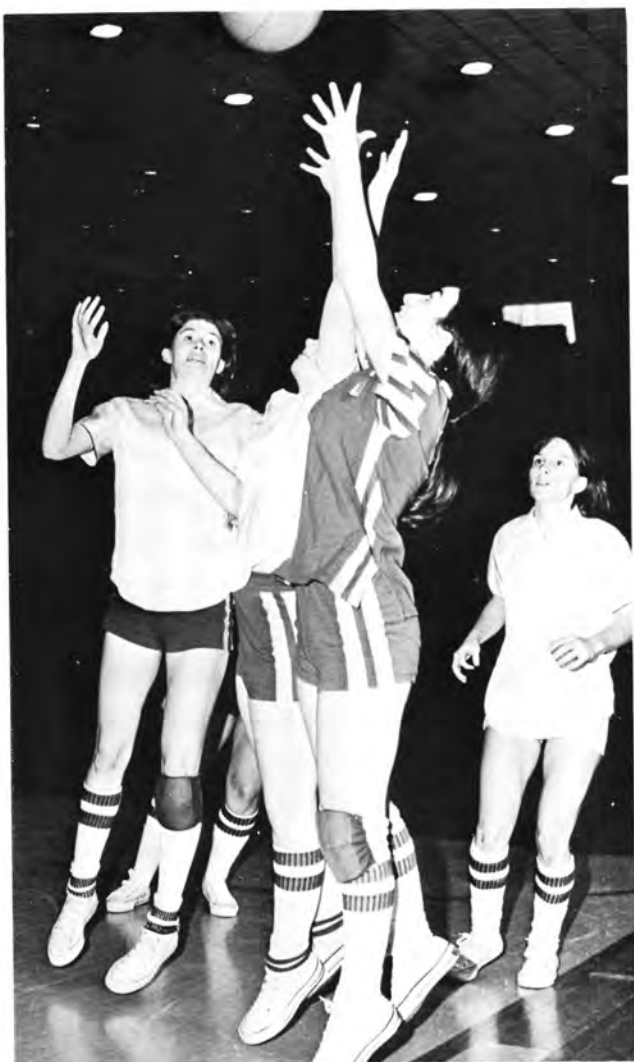
