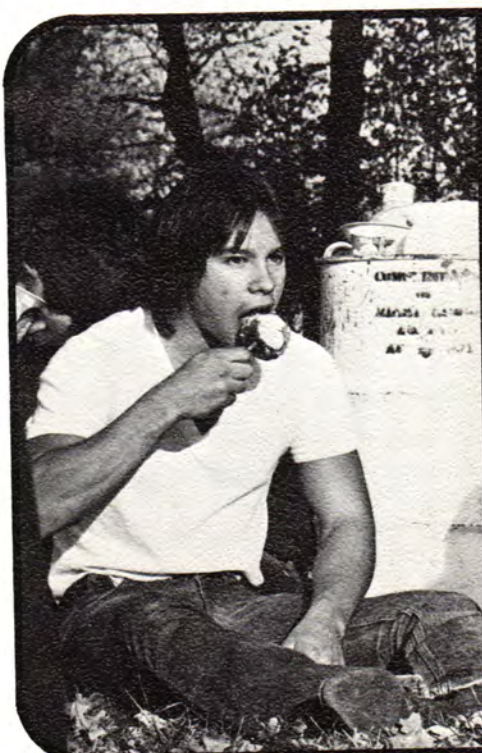
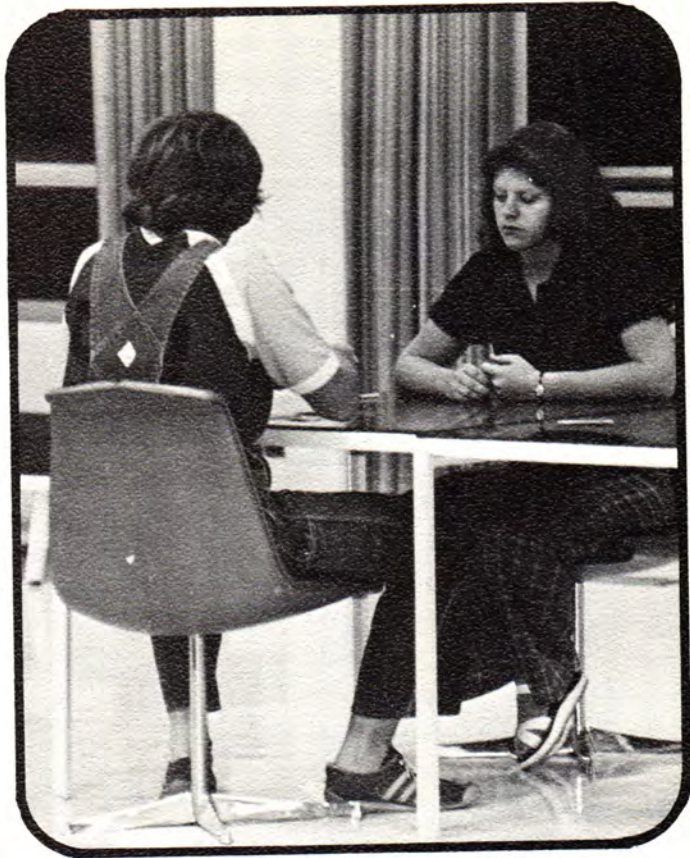


On Northeastern's Campus the wind blows
