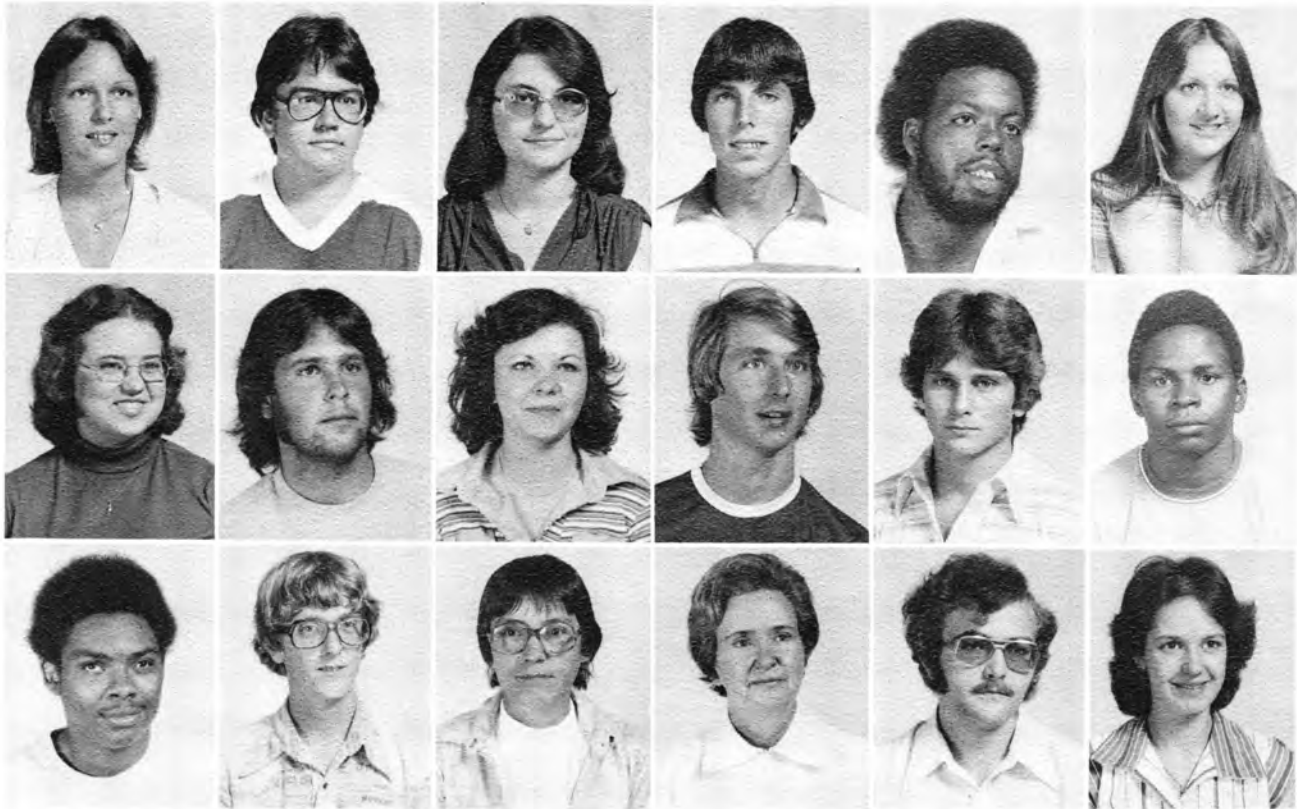

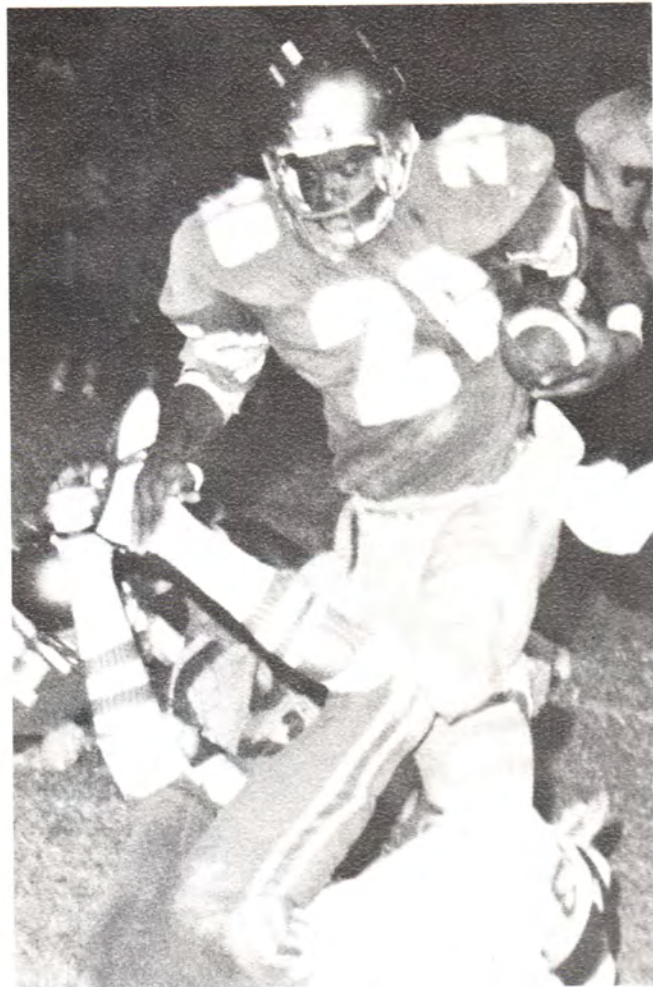

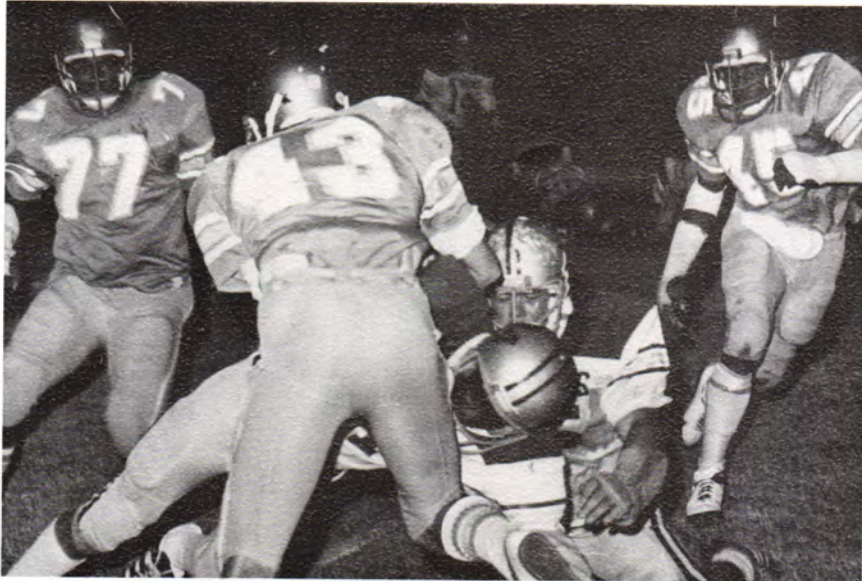

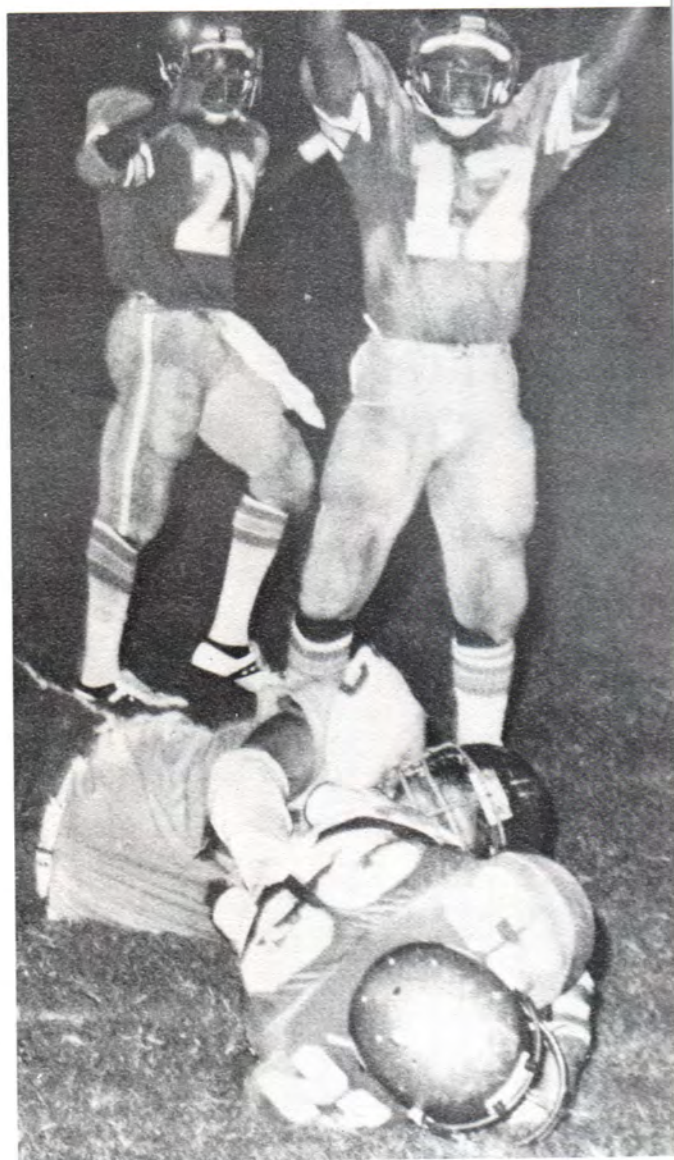

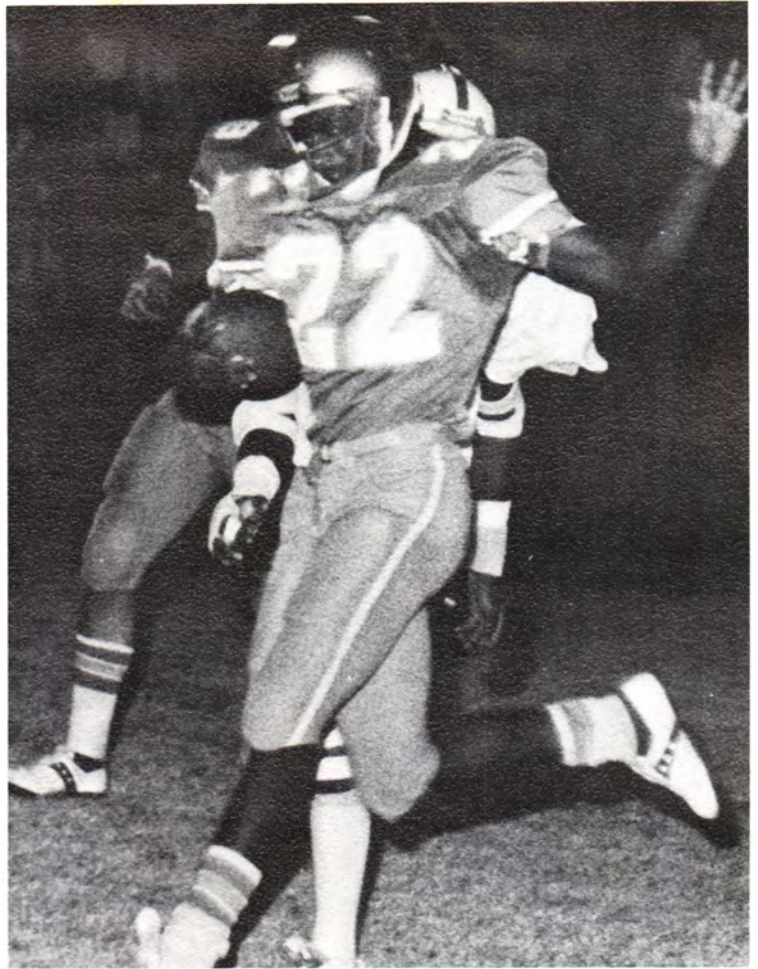

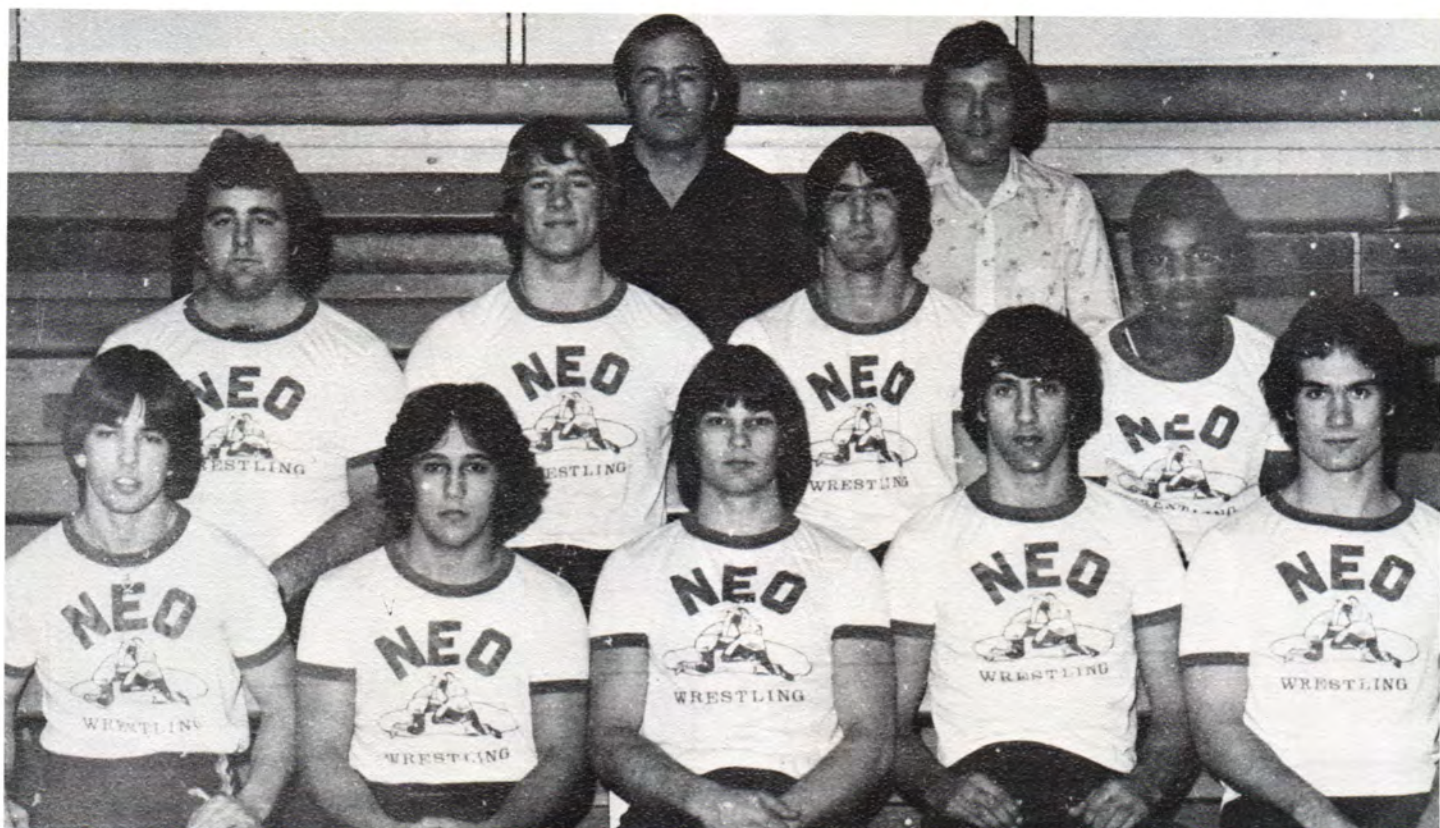

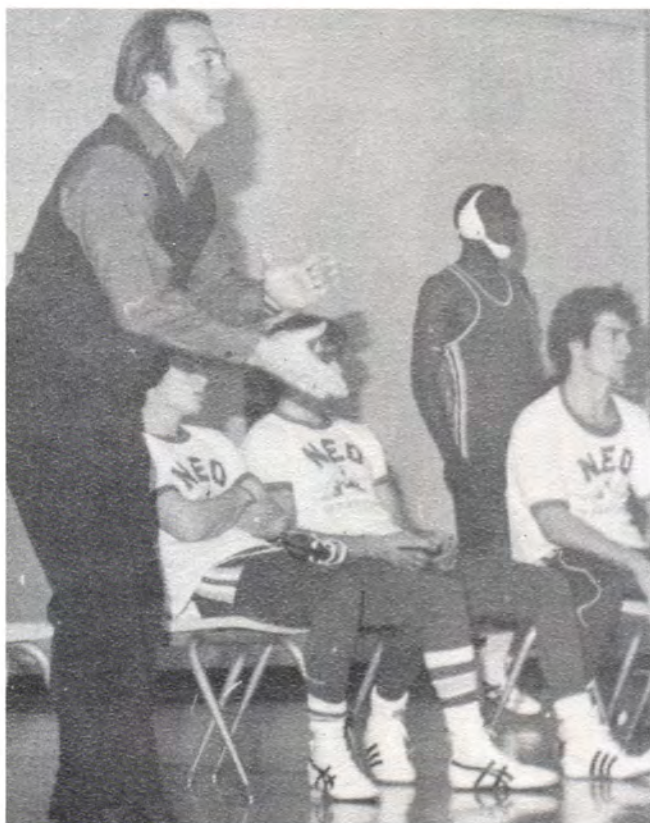

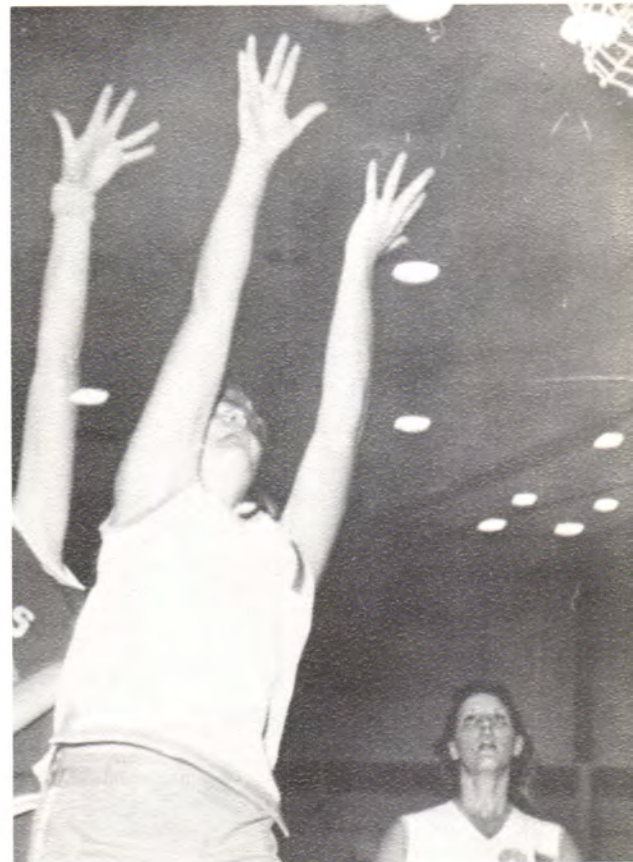

"Norsemen in the top 40" was the theme of the 1978 NEO Homecoming Parade. Floats and entries were based on titles of popular songs.

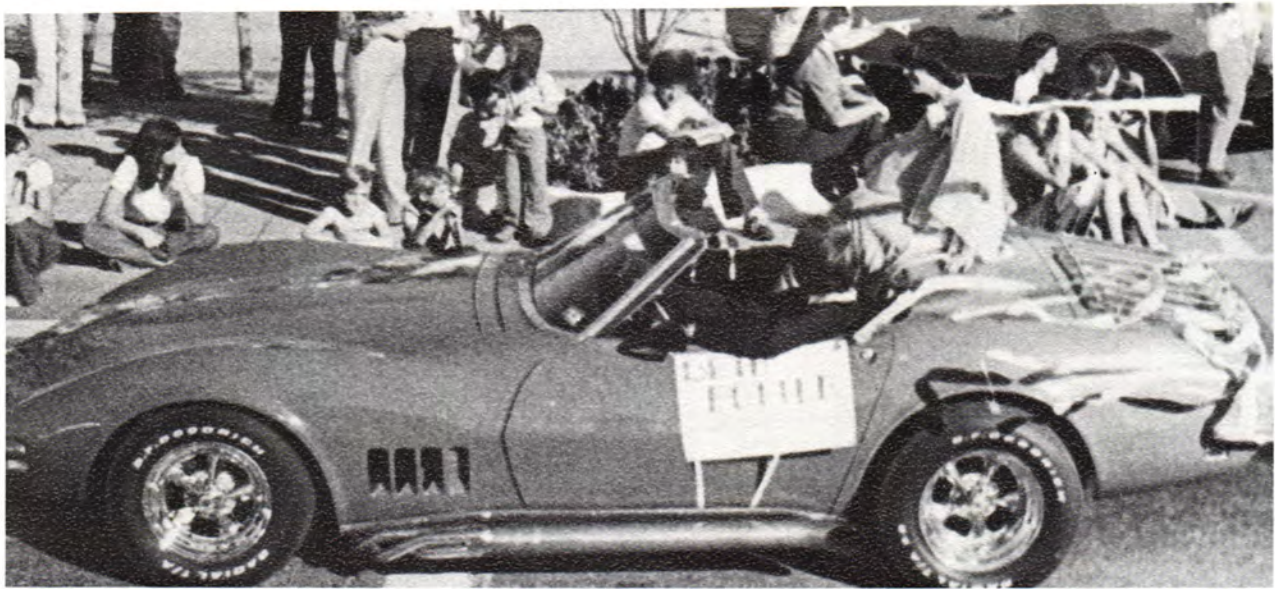
